This technique helps eliminate metabolic wastes, bolsters the immune system, and stimulates the parasympathetic relaxation response.

Once enrolled in this course, you will receive access to an online theory module. This must be completed prior to the 2 practical days on-campus (approxtimate 90 min duration). This will teach you the how, why and importance of the lymphatic system.




Reflexology
