# Advanced Dry Needling

# Myofascial Cupping

This workshop is based on the highly popular and sought-after cupping therapy that helps release muscular tension & assist in facial release. This is a great skill for therapists to learn as it is popular with clients and very low impact for therapists to perform. In this workshop only plastic and silicone cups are used to perform advanced cupping treatment techniques. The focus of this workshop is on treating musculoskeletal conditions with a range of advanced cupping techniques.

# Manual Lymphatic Drainage (MLD)

Manual Lymphatic Drainage (MLD) is a very gentle specialised body treatment that encourages the flow of lymph, enhancing the body's ability to recover and function naturally. This technique helps eliminate metabolic wastes, bolsters the immune system, and stimulates the parasympathetic relaxation response.



Once enrolled in this course, you will receive access to an online theory module. This must be completed prior to the 2 practical days on-campus (approximate 90 min duration). This will teach you the how, why and importance of the lymphatic system.

# Infant & Pregnancy Massage

You will learn the art of safely using flame or glass cups and will get the practice using both to apply a full body treatment.

# Kahuna Massage

Kahuna Massage has been practiced for many years and traditionally was kept a secret. Modern Kahuna training still aims to keep this tradition, but often just scratches the surface of the traditional training.

Kahuna massage for a therapist is often a lot more physically involved, with long strokes running from the head to the toe, all without breaking contact with your client.

Kahuna massage mainly uses forearms, with a different type of draping compared to traditional Swedish/Relaxation massage.

This workshop intends to teach an introduction to the practical art of Kahuna bodywork only, and is beneficial for therapists wanting to improve their forearm techniques or for people who are wanting to learn about Kahuna before they deep dive into traditional training.
